This upcoming Sunday, July 5, 2015, starting 10 AM, Henry Flynt will lead a walking tour of some places in SOHO where artists lived. The tour is largely about people he had some connection with.

It is a tour of addresses where the artists no longer reside. Many are deceased. Flynt will say a few words about his personal acquaintance with those he knew, and will indicate why a few are on the list with whom he had little personal connection. Many of the locations are outwardly antiquated and insignificant. What happened there, on the other hand, has had global repercussions of permanent significance—even if the admiration has lately diminished.

The tour has been limited to a few streets between Lafayette and Sixth Avenue to keep the amount of walking within bounds. Even so, a distance of three or four blocks in Manhattan can seem long.
