The participants will be:

Michel Auder is a video artist in New York who has compiled an ongoing video diary which is a candid chronicle of his life and the New-York art scene. Cast of his New York artist friends from Andy Warhol to Cindy Sherman. They are idiosyncratic, poetic video journal. He will show a 6 minutes video: "do you know who is Donald Cammell ?"

Michel Collet is an artist and theoretician who works with gestures, voices and pictures: ("the intermediate poem", "the walking man"), "The communion of the saints" (edition Erratum). His work has been shown in international galleries and cultural institutions. He is the founder of "Utomobile Club Charles Fourier."

Gerard Collin-Thiebaut sees himself as an author rather than a visual artist. He pushes the limits of perception of space, attitude, and questions the role of the artist in our society. He uses unconventional supports like subway and train tickets and other everyday life items. His works were shown for more than 20 years at L&M Durand Dessert, one of the most prominent galleries in Paris. He has a permanent space at the MAMCO, a contemporary museum in Geneva. His work has been shown in New York, Chicago, Montreal, Holland, etc...

Adam Kahan is a video artist living in Brooklyn New York. He will show 10 minutes of experimental video.

Nicola L resides in New York since the 70's. She has been involved with movies, installations, performances and functional art. She is represented by the gallery Patricia Dorfman in Paris. She has been

working on a New Project, the "bluecape", a performance that she plans to film around the world, starting in Cuba.

Patrice Lerochereuil is an artist who uses different media; paintings, drawings and performances. He has shown in Europe and in the United States where is a resident since 1989. He will present a 10 minute performance.

Larry Litt is a New York based artist mixing ritual and spoken word. He combines collages, videos, and rituals in his performances. Litt believes dissent = freedom.

Moira Tierney is an Irish filmmaker whose movies are highly personal. She has produced over 20 movies from personal portraits to sociopolitical commentaries. Her work has been shown internationally: Art Institute of San Francisco, London and Rotterdam film festivals, Cartier Foundation in Paris etc...

Valentine Verhaeghe works in multiple forms, describing the possibilities of everyday life. Those works are carried out as plays, performances, artist books, and electronic images. She has performed in the US, Spain, Quebec and France.
